Education Director Dyan McBride



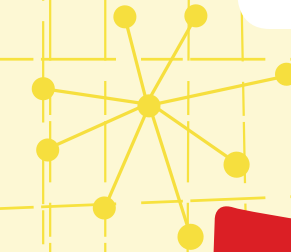

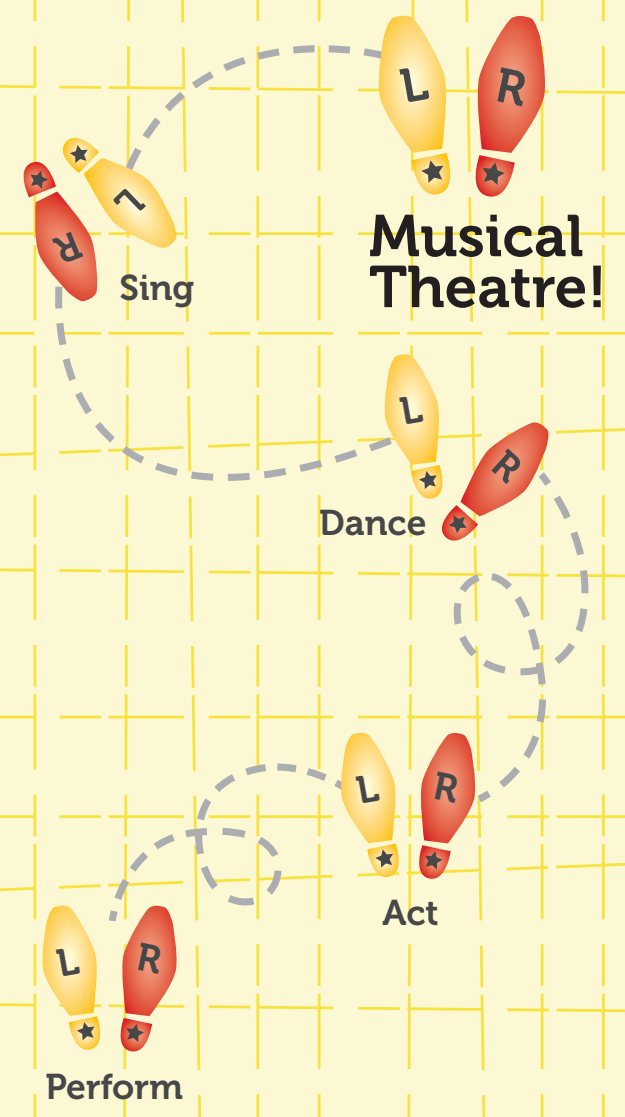

Now entering its second year, MoonSchool is the educational wing of 42nd Street Moon, the musical theatre gem of San Francisco. Moon's unique vision & history of producing work from the early 20th century through

the 1970's, gives MoonSchool an edge in terms of scholarship and song selection. We honor the past and move boldly into the future at MoonSchool. From George Gershwin to last year's Tony award-winning Matt Parker and Trey Stone, we sing it all!



We specialize in:

- Musical theatre classes for youth and adults.
- Private coaching in voice, dance, acting and piano.
- College audition preparation for both musical theatre and straight drama programs.
- Monologue, scene study, musical theatre history and dance intensives.
- Master classes featuring some of the finest singers, directors and dancers in the nation.
- Summer conservatory for our young, aspiring performers.

MoonSchool classes focus on

the components of musical theatre — sight-reading, music theory, musical theatre history, ear-training, vocal technique, acting, musical theatre dance, stage composition and scenework.

Each class begins with a physical and vocal warm-up, moves into a musical theatre dance lesson, slides into a few improvisational exercises and wraps up with singing and staging terrific musical theatre numbers.

Students perform for friends, family and Moon staff at the end of each trimester.



Musical Theatre 1: Rising Stars

Does your child sing along with TV commercials and radio jingles? Do they drag out all the musical instruments in the house? Have they ever tap danced in the grocery store? **Rising Stars** is a class for the budding musical theatre performer in your family. Kids learn basic music theory skills, how to pick up dance steps and play different characters in this fun class.

Musical Theatre 2: Aspiring Artists

If your tween/teen has run up your iTunes account on show music or they beg for a trip to NYC during spring break, perhaps **Aspiring Artists** is the class your kid needs on Saturday mornings. This course is tailored to the young person who has a serious interest in the study and performance of musical theatre or may be considering a career in the arts.

Musical Theatre 3: Leading Players

Master Classes

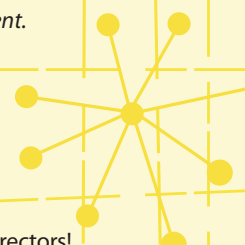

Intensives

These short sessions in monologue prep, scene study, musical theatre history and dance are aimed at the student that needs a jolt of inspiration, but is pressed for time. Intensives run three to four days and are goal-oriented and specific.

Summer Conservatory

This two-week summer course is aimed at students that want to know the ins and outs of putting on a show. Mornings are spent in rehearsal and afternoons are filled with building sets, props and costumes. This high energy, super silly theatre extravaganza ends with a two-show day and a party. Show title will be released in January 2012.

 Tuition: \$350 (1/2 day), \$700 (full day)



When are classes? Classes run for 9 weeks and culminate in performance. The final day of each trimester is the recital date.

2011/12 Winter Trimester: Jan 9 – Mar 11
2012 Spring Trimester: Apr 9 – June 10

Performers of all ethnic and cultural backgrounds are encouraged to attend MoonSchool. Scholarships are available.
